EA HIE Update

- Food and Drink Trail has had a nice uptake in customers since we released the route. Initially we ran weekly competitions but due to dip in engagement that will be moved to monthly.
- Success of F&D Trail has led to starting VMS Restaurant Week, development has started with a look to run the campaign from $13^{th} 19^{th}$ November.
- Complete works training moved from July to October to fit in with less busy season for businesses. This has led to better uptake already. Separate customer service training course will be run through UHI.
- Travel Trade workshop with VisitScotland is in the works for 24^{th} of October with morning and afternoon session dedicated to people already dealing with TT and people who are not yet. FAM trip will run on 16^{th} and 17 November.
- EA currently working on research for map leaflet which has been asked from numerous people as Toursim Network Meetings. EA in contact with Helen Stirling.

BF HIE Update

- Heritage Lottery Fund has been put out to community groups and Keith and Aberlour interested in applying. Moray Heritage Connections are up and running with David Mackay but first meeting was postponed.
- BF's Winter Festival work is underway, 14 groups have applied for funding of up to £5000 that will come from HIE funding. Events will run on Nov, Dec and Jan but not necessarily for Christmas events. Guide will be produced with all events running through region.
- BF and EA are still running Tourism Network Meetings, Forres, Speyside, Buckie coming up, Lossiemouth on hold, Keith in progress.

The funds have not been paid due to the refurb still on-going. Once completion report and photos have been received the payment will be made. Findhorn have made a second application and this is just in progress Forres have been in contact to consider an application for the Grant Park toilets Portknockie Paddling Pool Group have submitted a second application for mens toilets – this has been approved just waiting for work to be completed.
